The Brakspear Brewhouse at the Wychwood Brewery today houses original brewing equipment from Henley including the Brakspear copper and unique ‘double drop’ system. Brakspear remains as it has always been, The Original Taste of Oxfordshire.

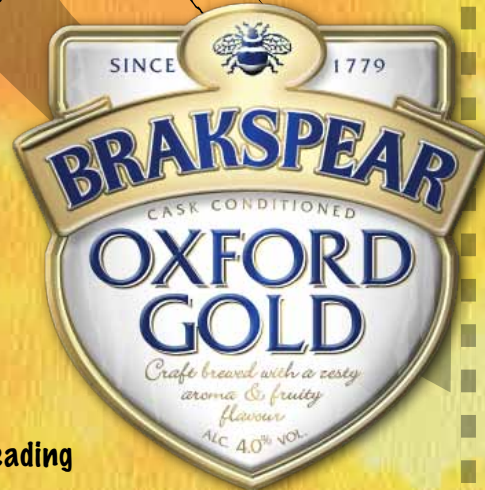
